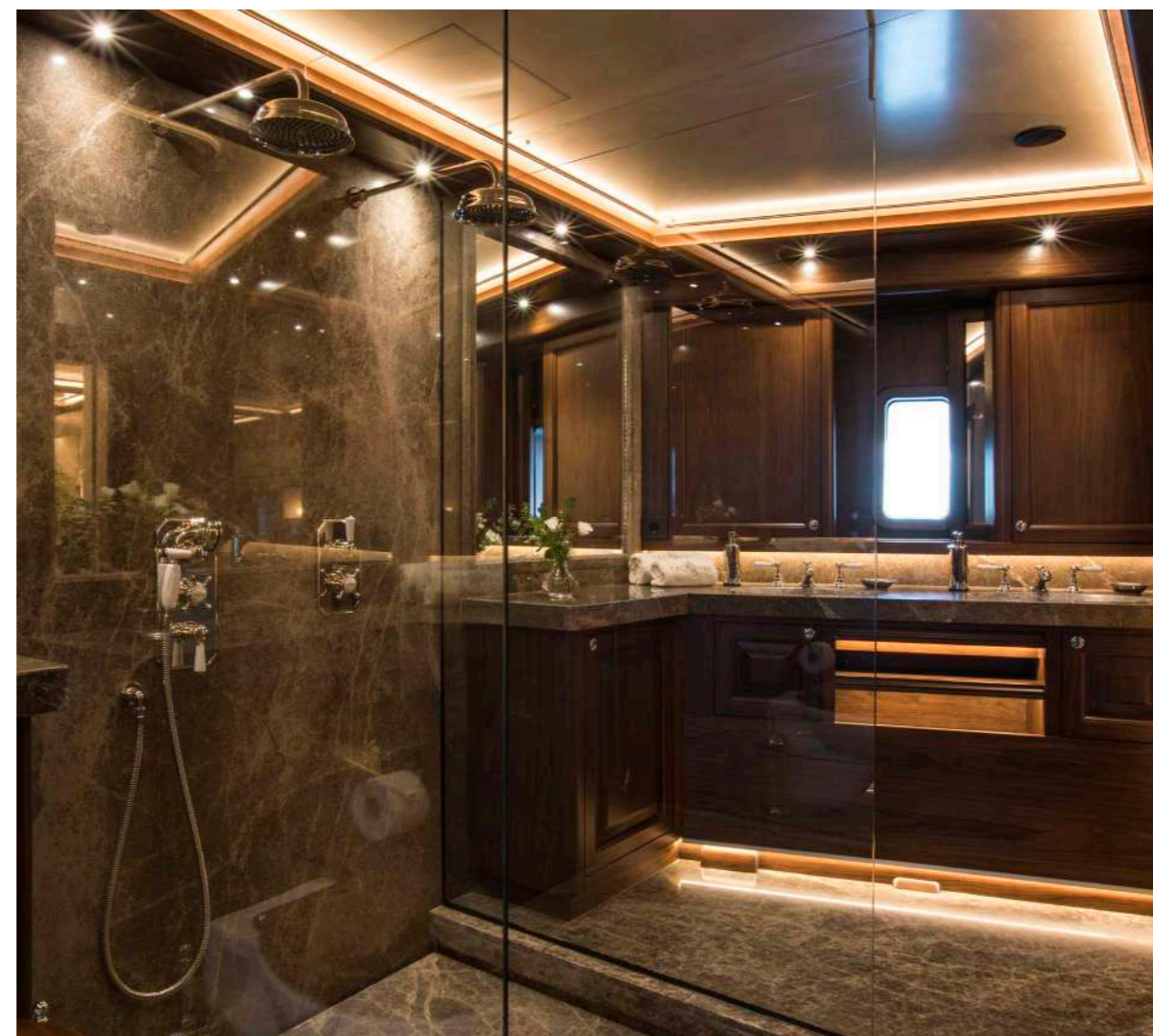
An Ode to **CLASSIC ELEGANCE**

Finished in glossy mahogany and walnut with teak floors throughout, Satori embodies the slow-living spirit of by-gone-era sailing – refined for contemporary life.

Life ON BOARD

Satori is not defined solely by her design, but by how she is lived. Multiple decks offer distinct environments for socialising or privacy, while the captain's wheelhouse and crew areas remain entirely separate, ensuring freedom and discretion at all times.





DECK LAYOUT

Mid Deck

Mid-deck, the open-view kitchen, bar, and dining area are positioned for maximum privacy and uninterrupted sea views. Here, guests are invited to observe the chef at work, turning dining into a quiet performance framed by the horizon.



DECK LAYOUT *Aft Deck*

At the aft end of the deck, a coffee-lounge-style area features a second bar, deep seating, and a large covered daybed — a relaxed social space for morning espresso or sunset aperitifs.



DECK LAYOUT *Forward Deck*

The forward deck is devoted to cinema and solitude, boasting a state-of-the-art, fold-away cinema screen and a large sunbed for guests to bask in the warmth of the sun and the gentle rise and fall of the waves.

Upper Deck

The top deck offers even more options for private sunbathing, with a row of sunbeds commanding spectacular views over the water, while old-fashioned deck chairs situated mid-deck add to the quintessential feeling of sailing upon the seas.

CABINS

Satori's five guest cabins are designed with refined comfort and thoughtful proportions, each offering privacy, natural light, and en-suite facilities.

The layout accommodates up to 10 guests and can be tailored to individual needs, including configuring one cabin as a private spa with a steam room for bespoke wellness experiences.

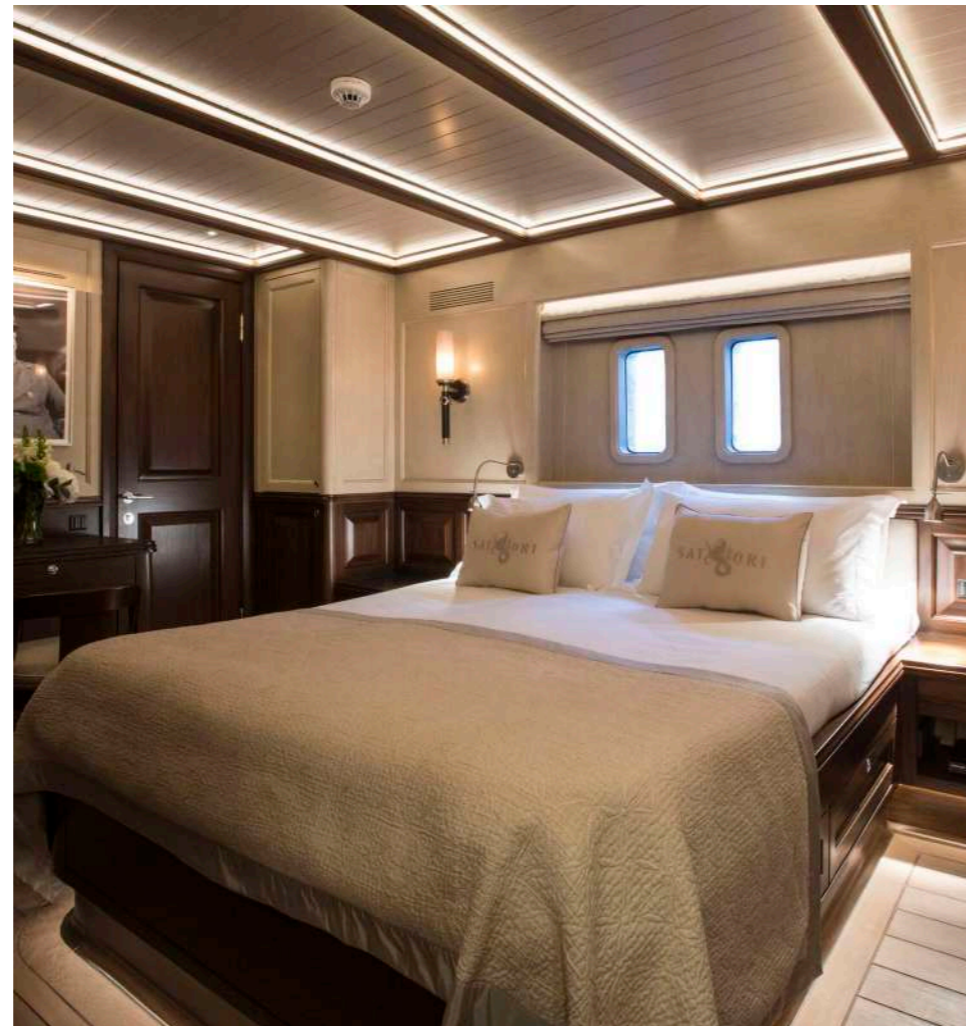


CABIN *Overview*

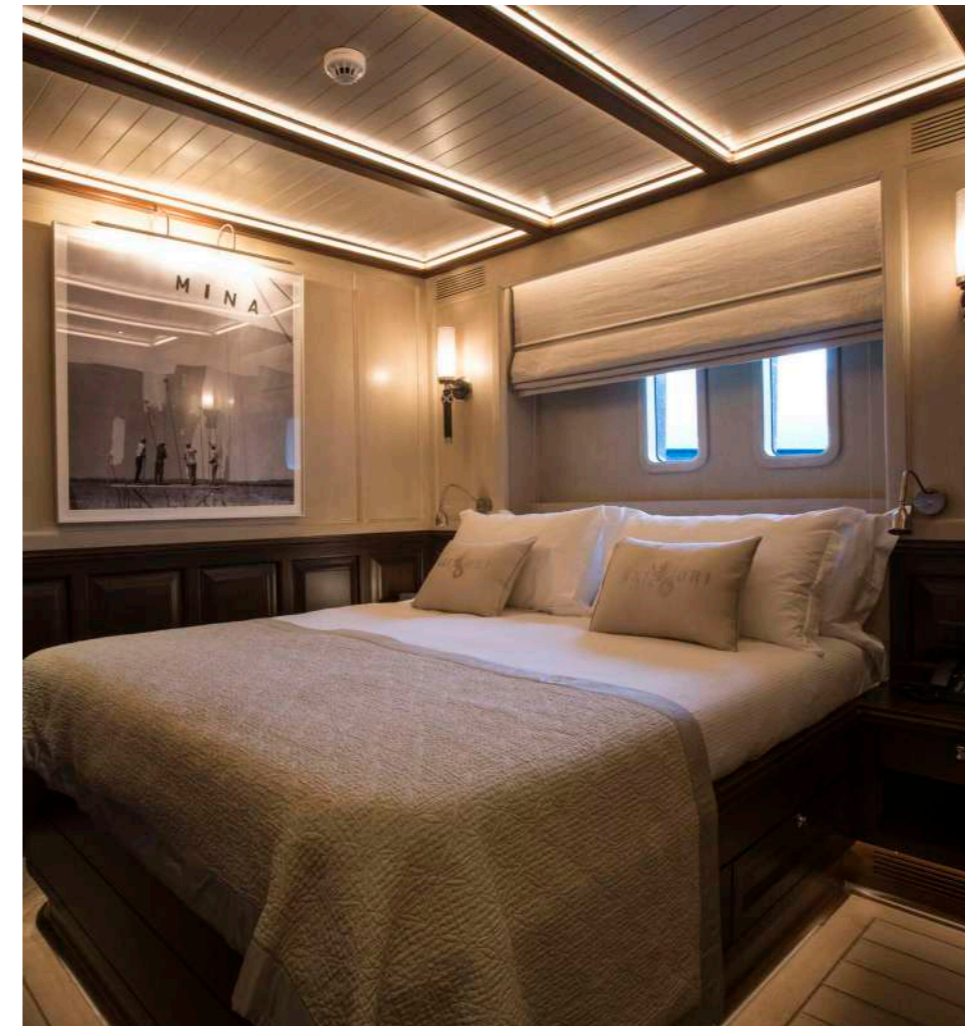

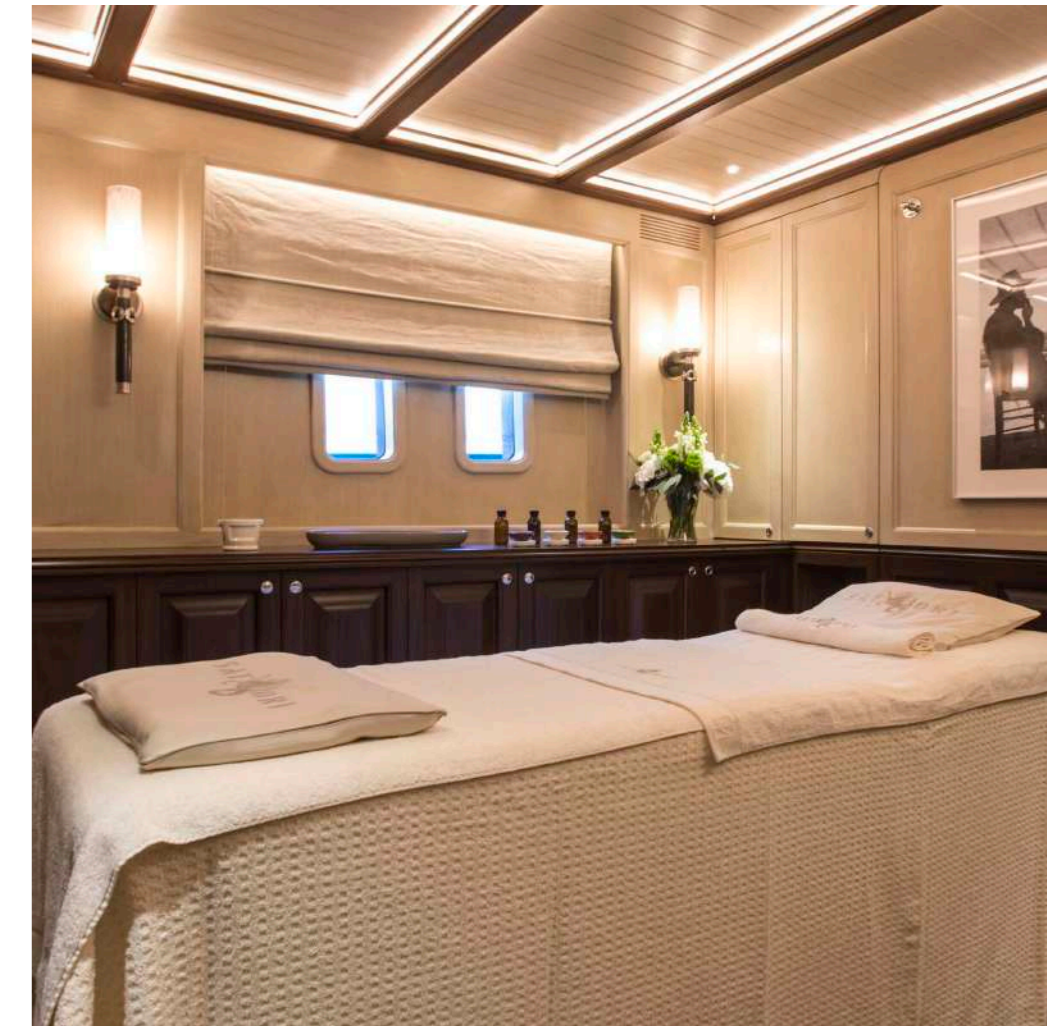

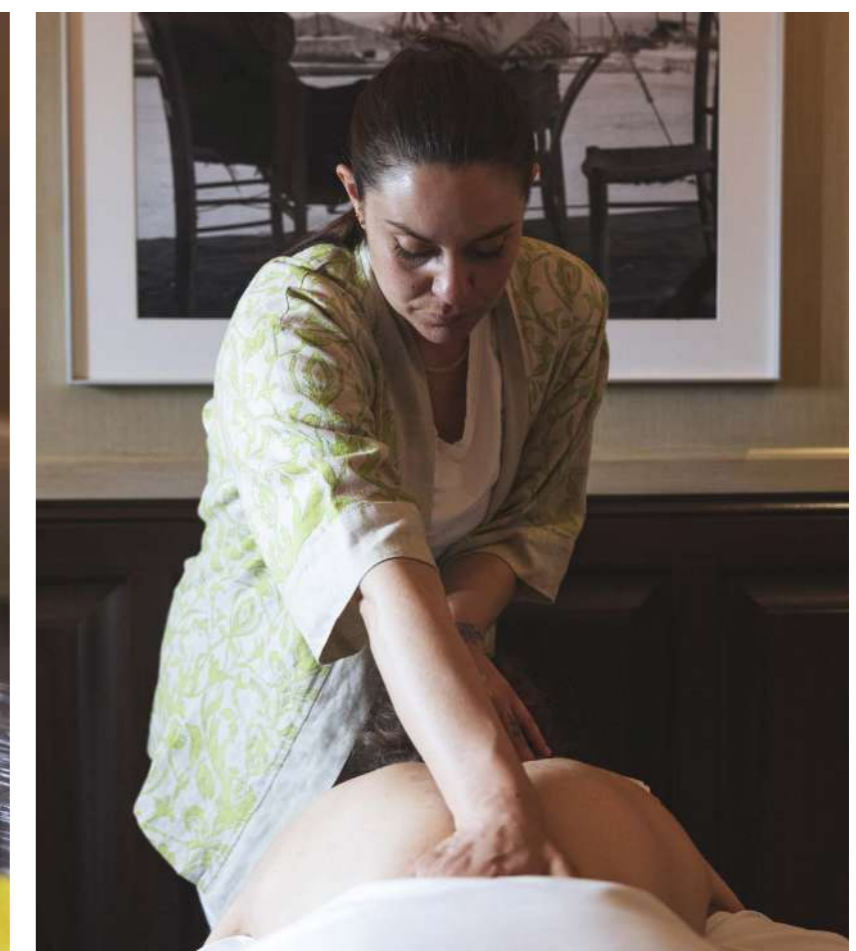

WELLNESS & Care

A private wellness cabin, equipped with a steam bath and convertible into an additional guest cabin, allows guests to tailor their experience before sailing. Personal therapists trained at the Seed to Skin Tuscany flagship Spa in Borgo Santo Pietro can be arranged on board, offering bespoke massages and treatments to restore body and mind after long days of sun and salt air.

DINING *Philosophy*

Dining is a central ritual aboard Satori. The open-view kitchen and mid-deck dining space invite guests to watch their personal chef at work, from the first preparations to the final plating, while enjoying complete privacy in harbour.

Menus are shaped around each guest's preferences and the rhythm of the day — from vibrant, health-focused dishes to generous, flavour-led recipes inspired by the shores touched along the route.

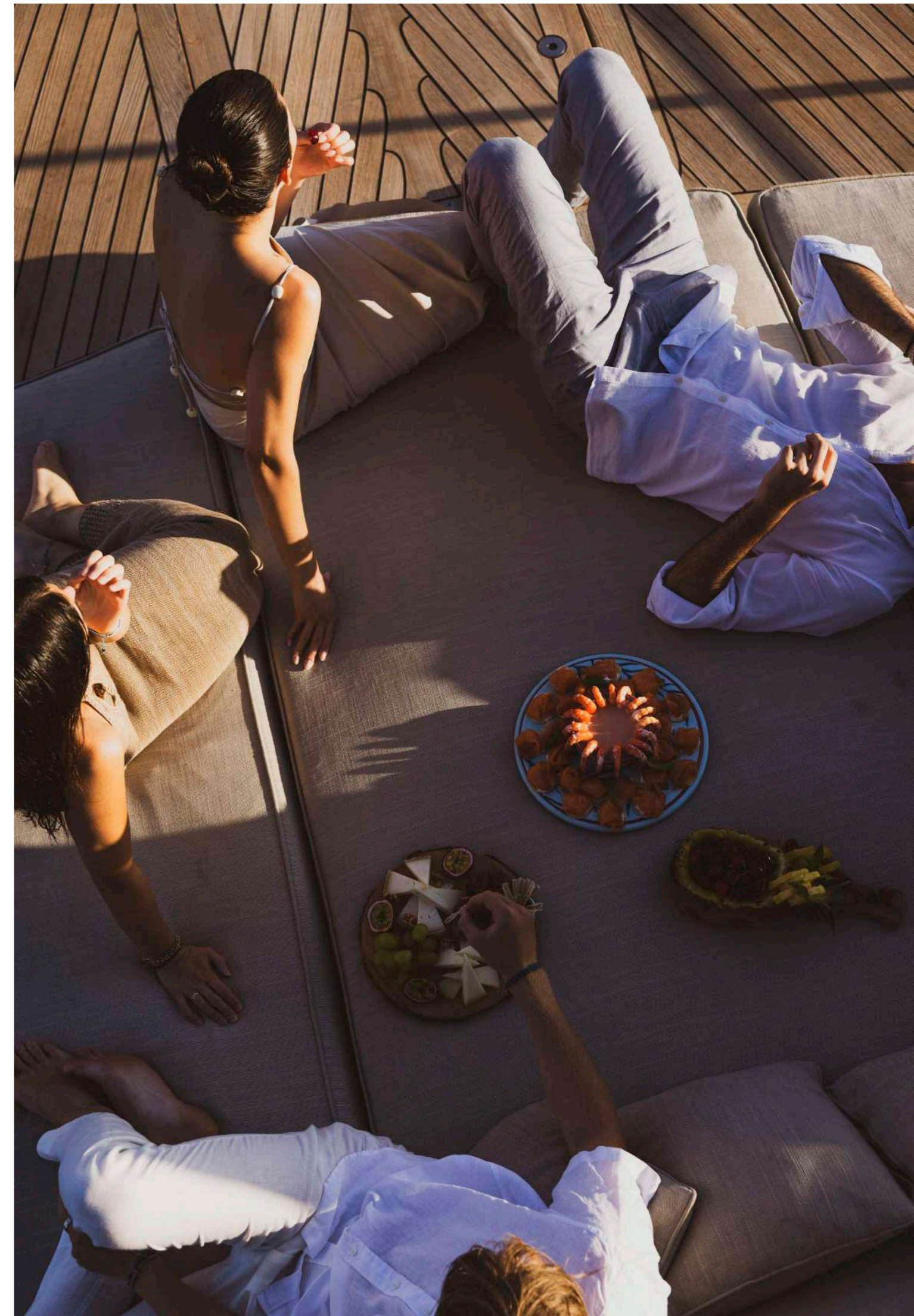


DINING *Philosophy*



Ingredients are selected daily for peak freshness, combining vegetables harvested from the Borgo Santo Pietro estate, the catch of the day, and exceptional local produce sourced along the journey.

Led by chefs trained at Michelin-starred Saporium and Trattoria sull'Albero, each meal is composed with flavour and care, and paired from an air-conditioned wine cellar holding up to 250 bottles.



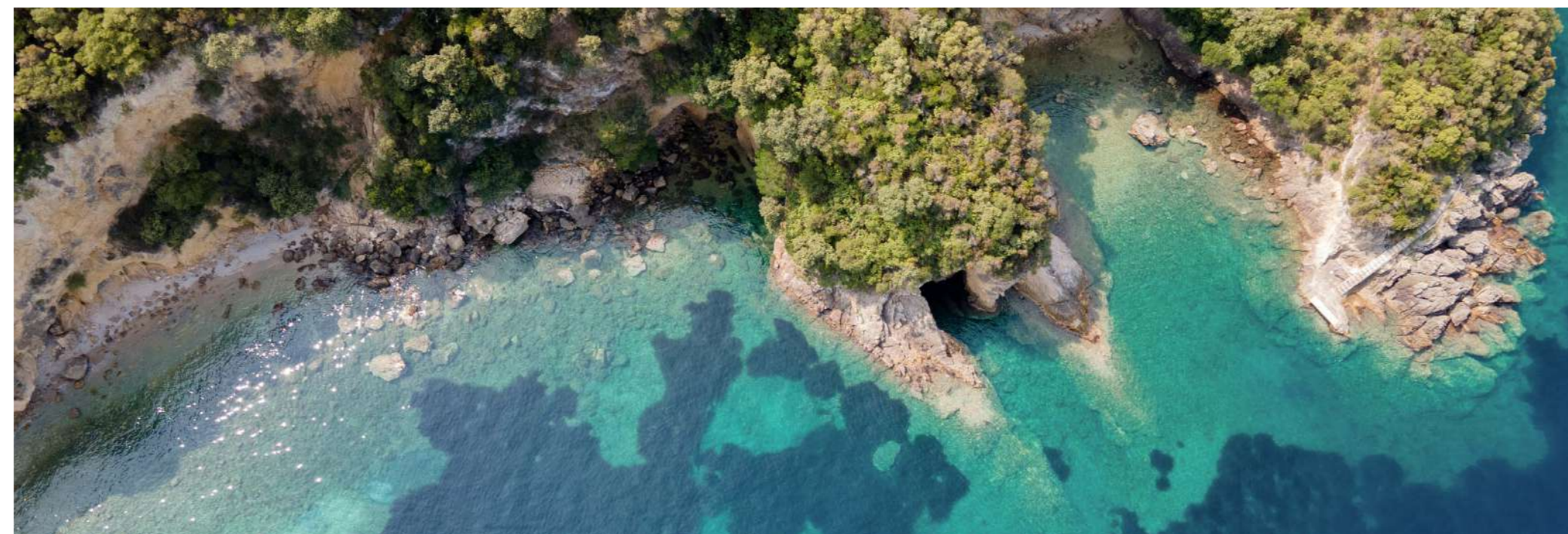
DINING *Philosophy*

Bespoke ITINERARIES

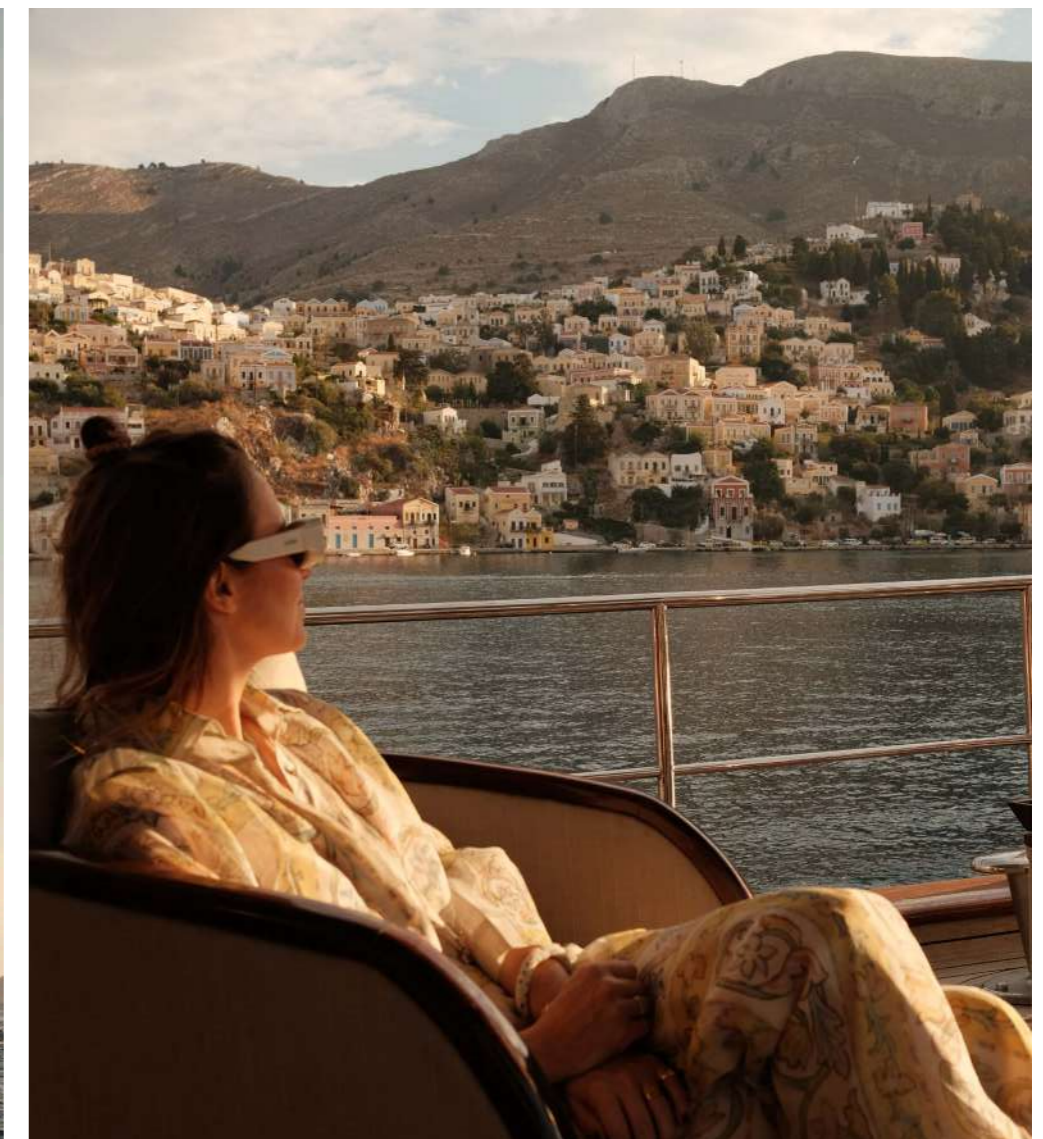

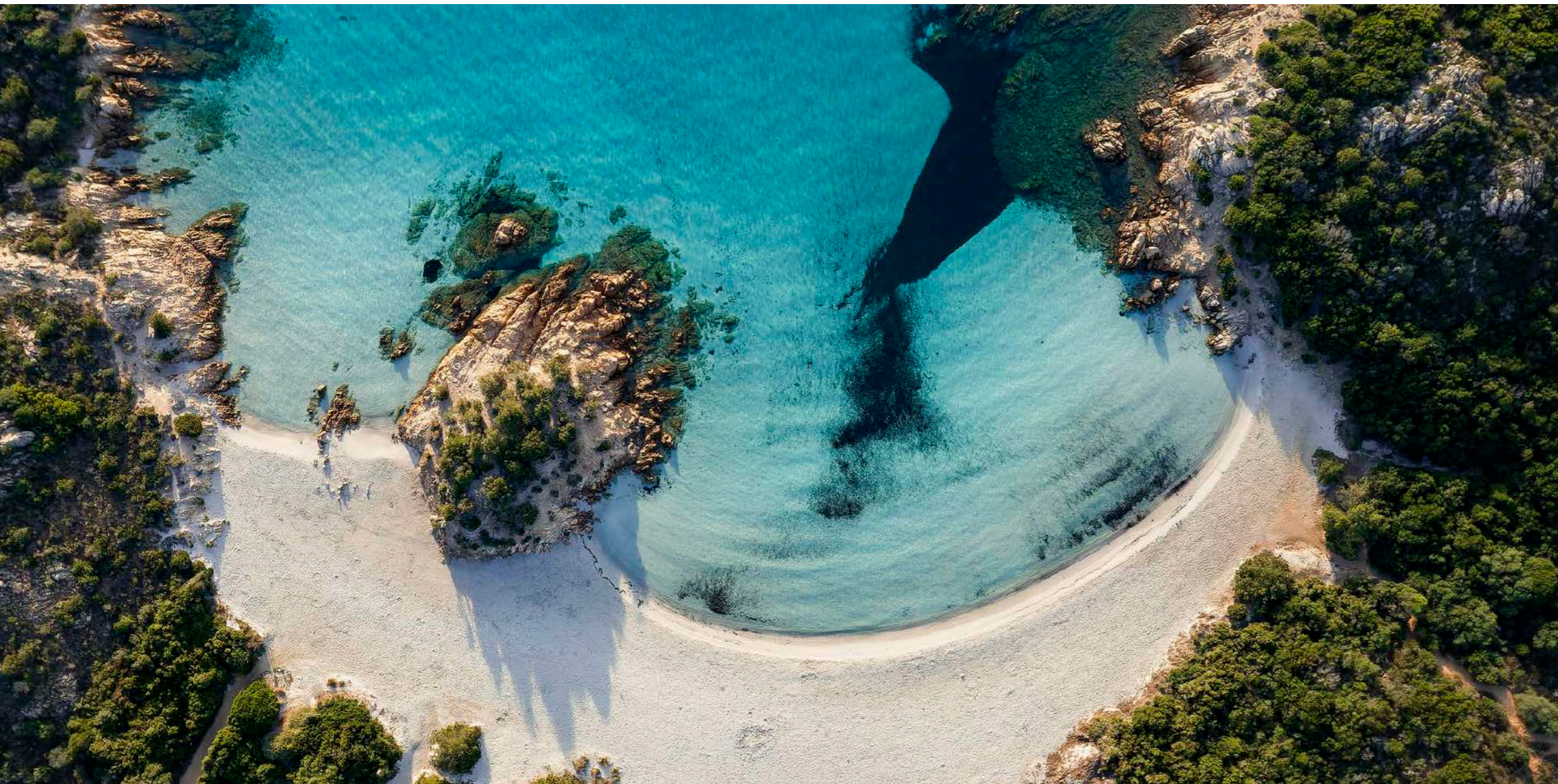




Bespoke ITINERARIES

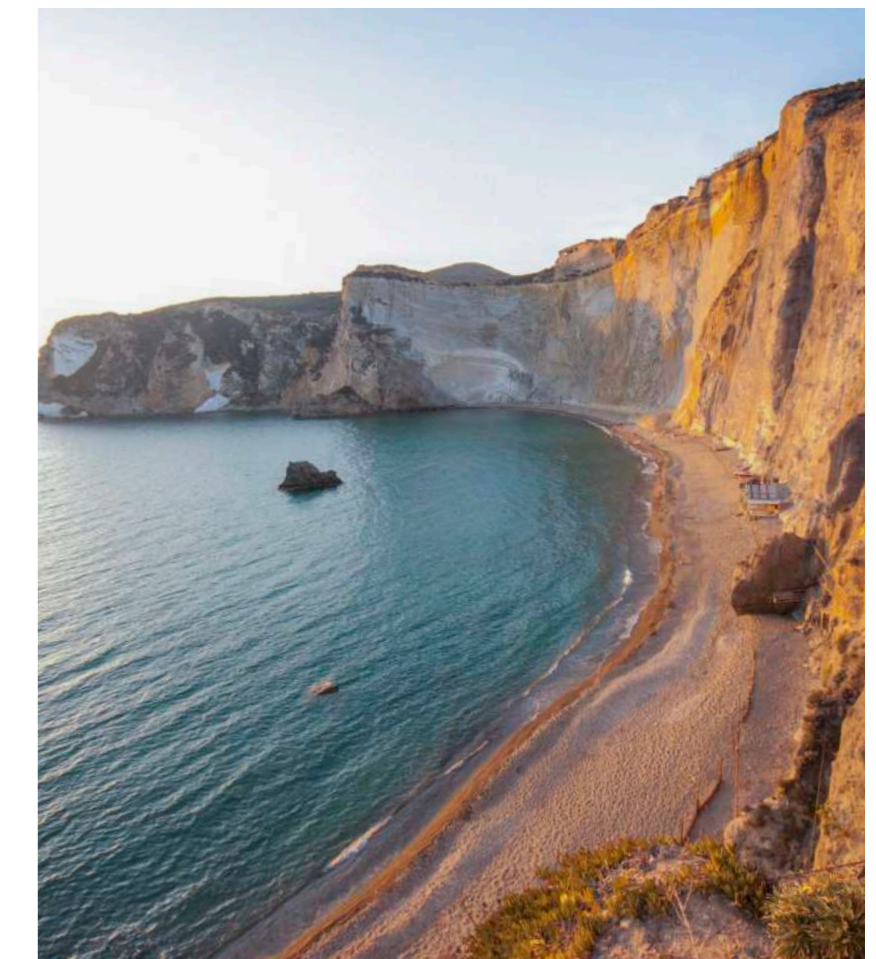




ITALY

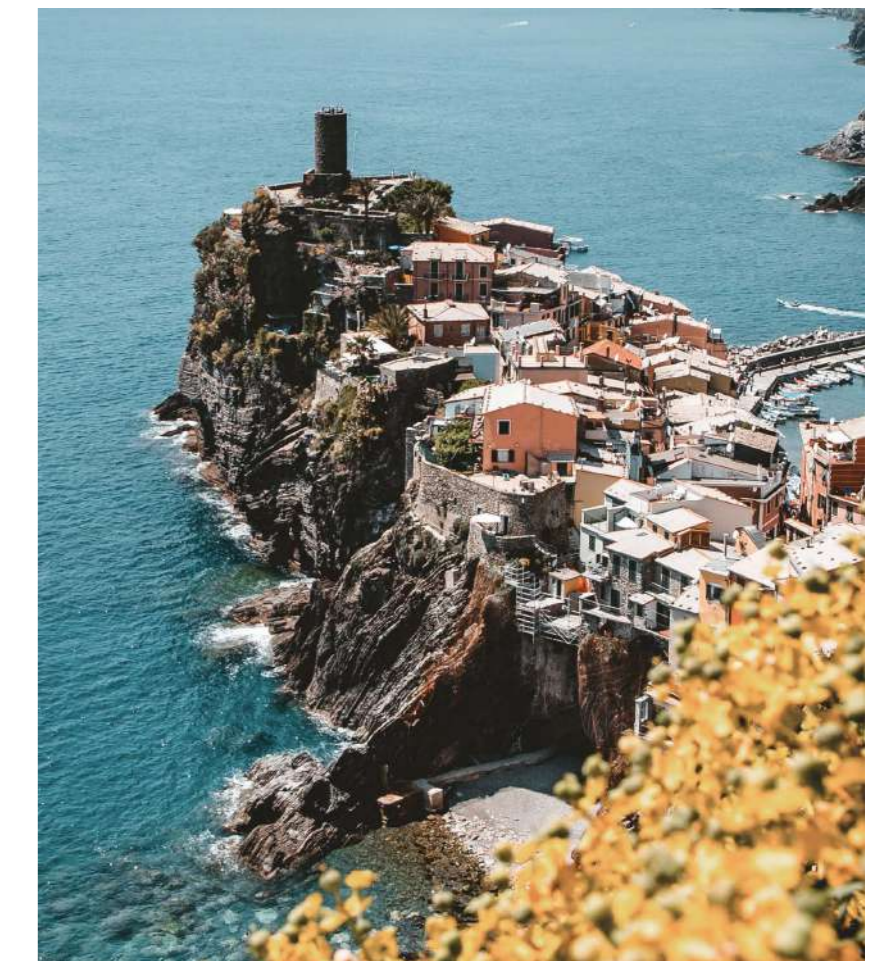


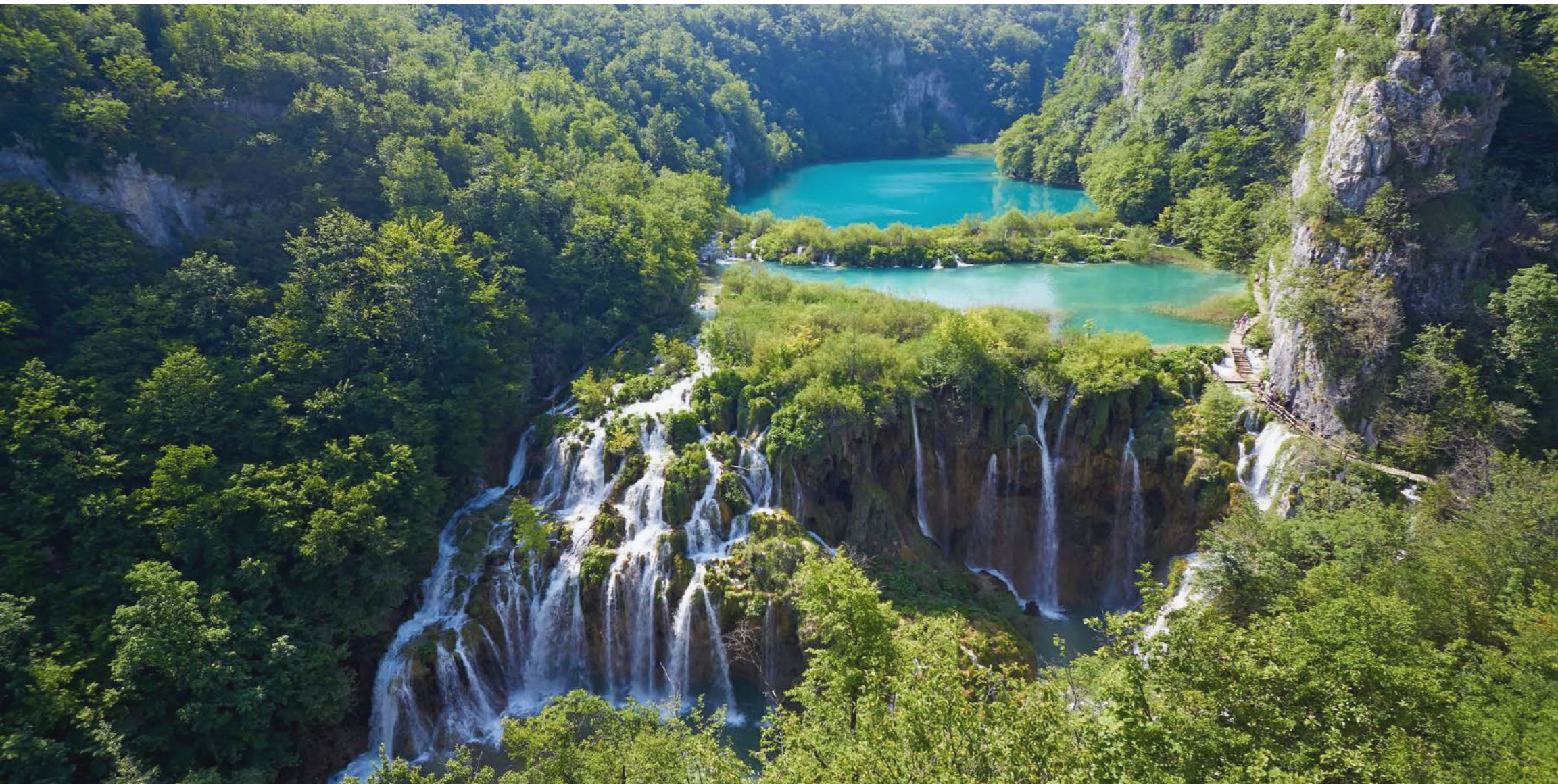


FRENCH & ITALIAN RIVIERAS

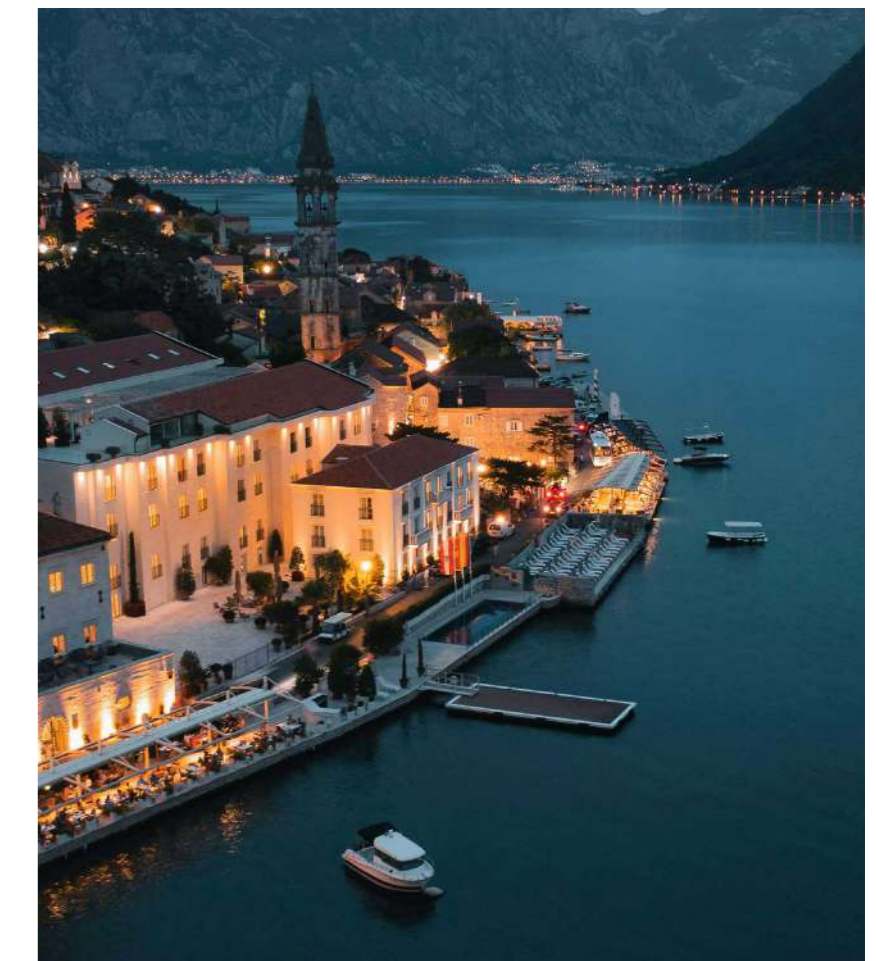




CROATIA & MONTENEGRO

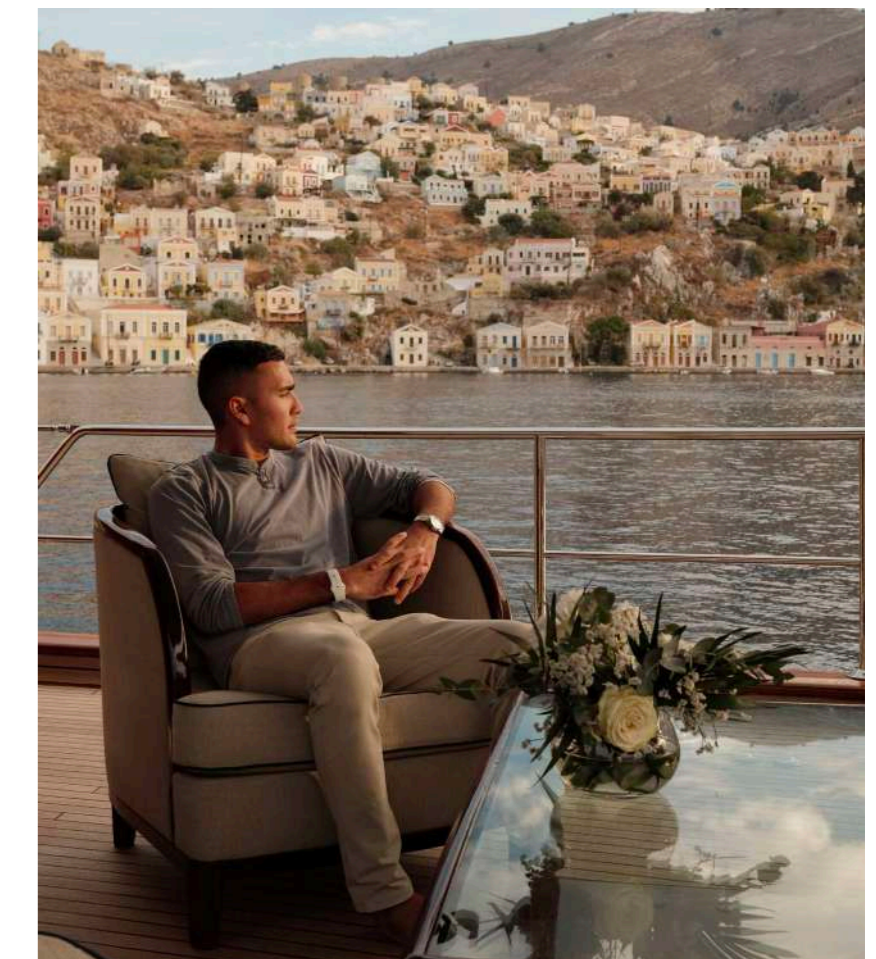




GREECE

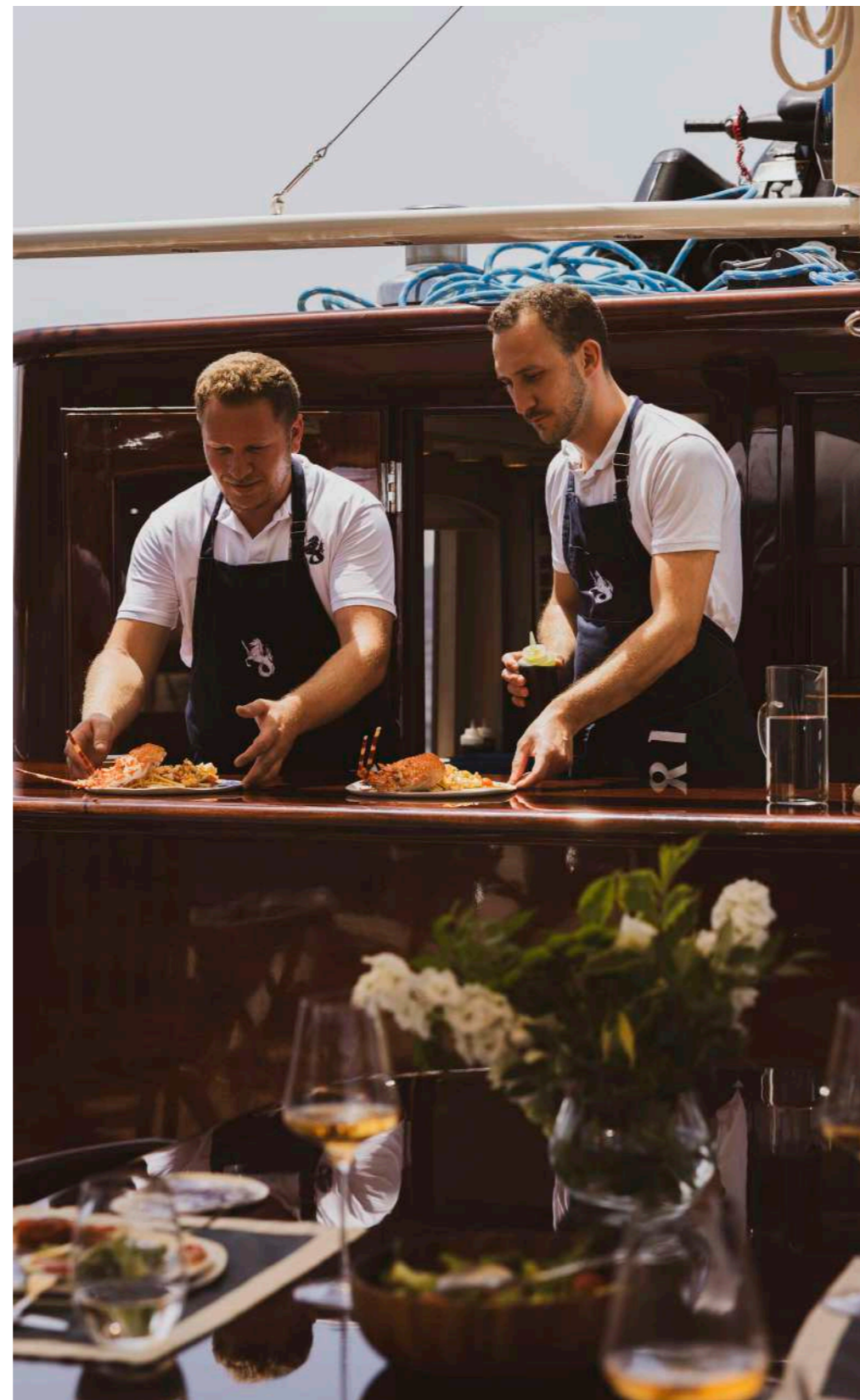
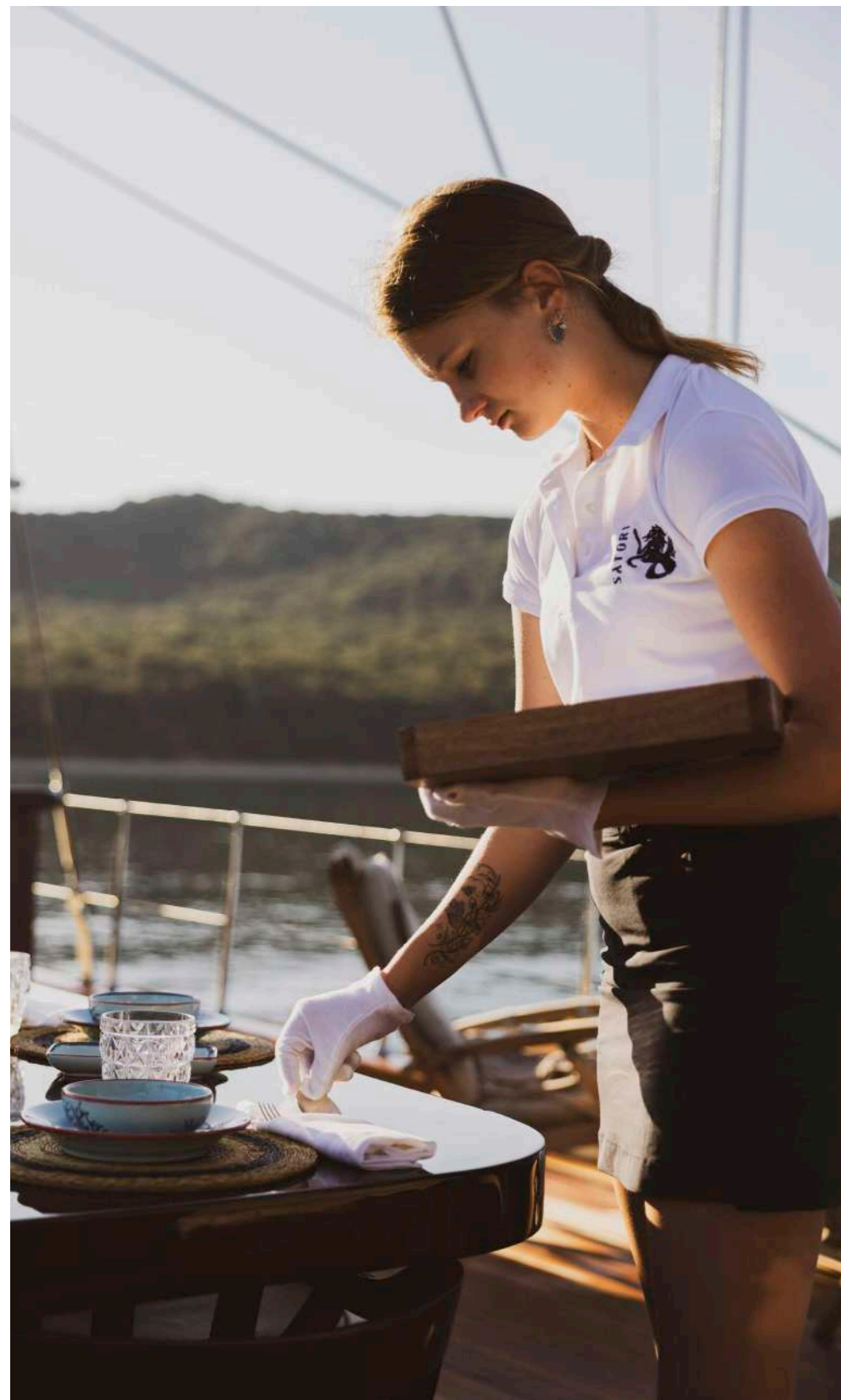
Blue-lagoon sailing begins the moment guests step into the sea via Satori's telescopic swim ladder, descending directly into crystalline waters.

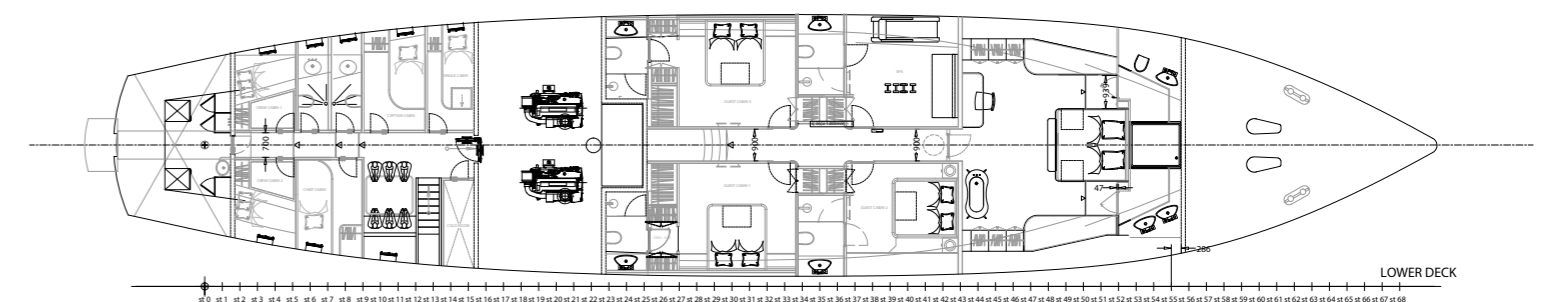
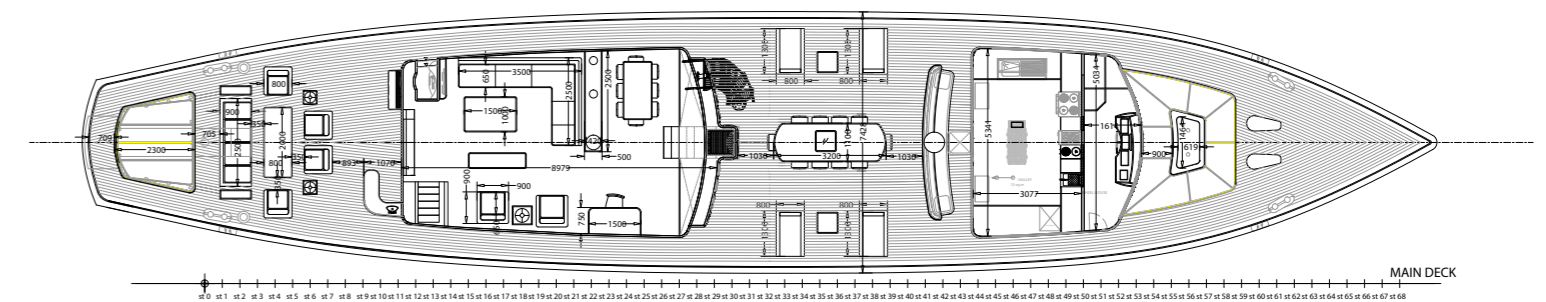
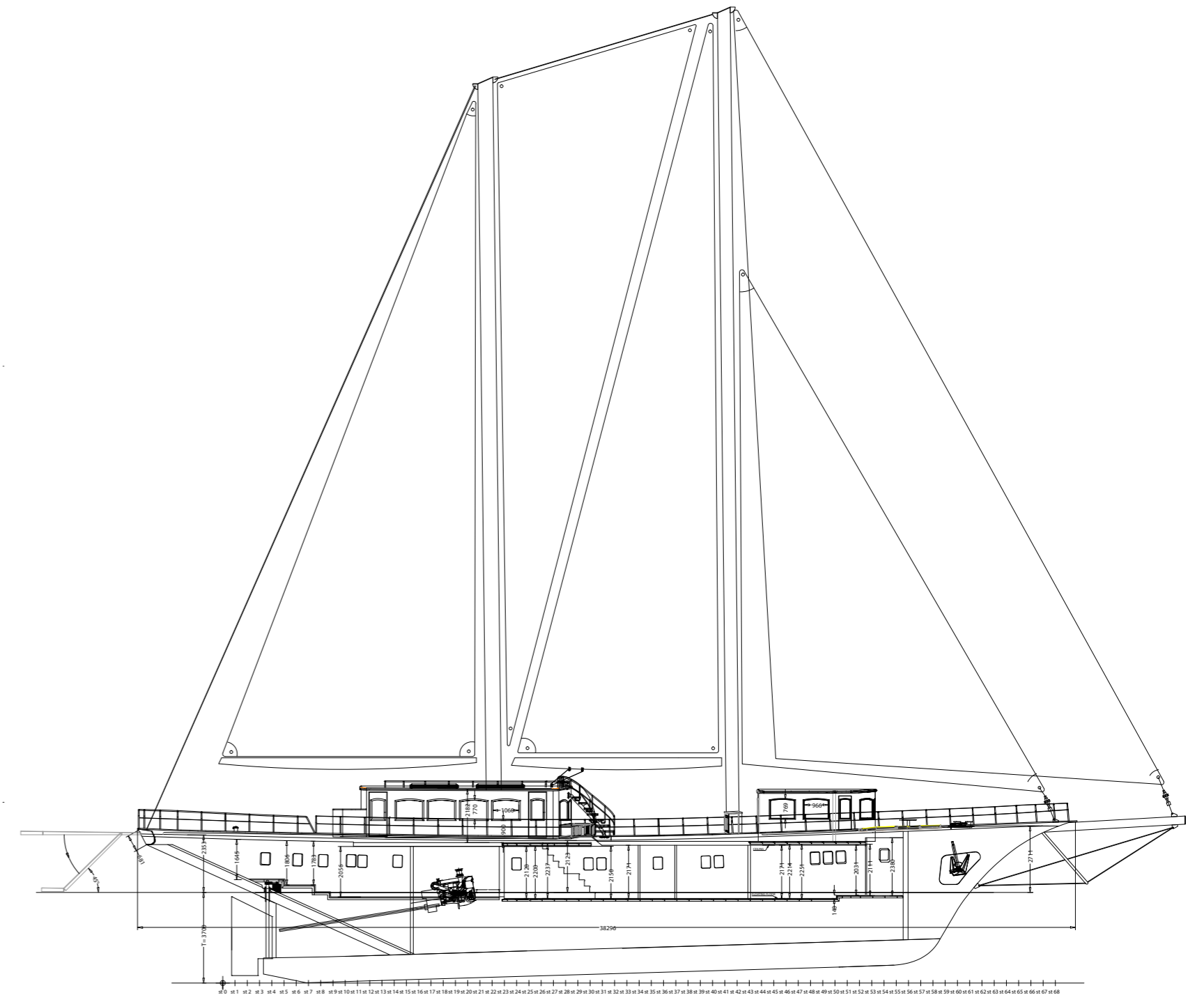
